The board of directors will then contact those members to determine who was present at the time of the incident and will recommend disciplinary actions up to and including suspension or termination. Any member who does not pick up when they are through shooting will be asked to appear before the E-Board to explain the reasons they failed to clean-up the range after they have finished, we do not have paid help to pick up after other members and expect everyone to treat the range and club as they would expect others to treat their property. Please do not shoot at the Target stands, you are damaging club property that is being provided for all members.
