Trout Pond

There is a 3 fish per day limit and will be strictly enforced.

FYI...

Trout Pond – Still fish in the pond to be caught, best times are early morning or late afternoon as it cools down for the fall season.

Trap – Trap League is open to the public on Monday nights, \$3.00 per round. Shooting is open for hand throwers for all other times. Please be sure to display the Orange flag in the holder on the telephone pole when shooting on the Trap range at all times, there is a third flag in the clubhouse as well as a flag stored in the trap building.

Outdoor shooting ranges – The outdoor ranges are open, the orange flag MUST be posted when shooting the outdoor pistol, rifle and trap ranges, if the black flag is posted the range is closed for maintenance.

Any member who does not pick up when they are through shooting will be asked to appear before the E-Board to explain the reasons they failed to clean-up the range after they have finished, we do not have paid help to pick up after other members and expect everyone to treat the range and club as they would expect others to treat their property. Please do not shoot at the Target stands, you are damaging club property that is being provided for all members.
