Trout Pond

The trout pond is open for button holder members with a 2017 button during normal daylight hours. There is a 3 fish per day limit and will be strictly enforced.

Trap – Trap league is open to the public on Monday nights from 4:00 pm until dusk; cost per round is \$3.00, See Armand LeFebvre for schedule of match nights.

The trap range will be open Sunday mornings as long as there are sufficient shooters, open to the public and cost \$3.00 per round, shooting will start after 09:00 am.

Shooting from hand thrower is allowed during normal daylight hours. Please be sure to display the Orange flag in the holder on the telephone pole when shooting on the Trap range at all times, there is a third flag in the clubhouse as well as a flag stored in the trap building.

Outdoor shooting ranges – The outdoor ranges are open for the year, please observe the range rules and pick up after shooting, there is no shooting allowed from in front of the shooting stations other than a scheduled police training session.

Anyone caught violating the range rules will be brought before the E-board for a discipline hearing and punishment up to and including removal from the club roster.

Please remember that All repairs to the Indoor Pistol range are to be performed by Authorized personnel Only, some of the light fixtures have been damaged by well meaning members changing the bulbs.

It is every members responsibility to pick up the ranges when they are through, we will be monitoring activity and checking the gate tracking database whenever an incident is reported to identfy all members who used the range during that time frame. The board of directors will then contact those members to determine who was present at the time of the incident and will recommend disciplanary actions up to and including suspension ot termination. Any member who does not pick when they are through shooting will be asked to appear before the E-Board to explain the reasons they failed to clean-up the range after they have finished, we do not have paid help to pick up after other members and expect everyone to treat the range and club as they would expect others to treat their property. Please do not shoot at the Target stands, you are damaging club property that is being provided for all members.
