FYI ...

Trout Pond

The Trout pond will be opening for the New Year Saturday April 28, 2018 starting at 8am following opening cannon shot for club members only with 2018 button.

Sunday April 29, 2018 starting at 8am for all 2018 button holders.

Buttons must be displayed at all times while fishing.

New 2018 Trout pond buttons can be picked up at the club during scheduled meetings and as arranged with Doug Latulippe, buttons will not be sent through the US Mail MUST be picked up in person.

Trap – Trap league is opening Monday April 2, 2018 4pm until dusk weather permitting; cost is \$3.00 per round of 25 clays public welcome.

Trap Team match nights Tuesday and Wednesday starting 6:30pm.

Flag must be displayed at all times while shooting.

Shooting from hand thrower is allowed during normal daylight hours. Please be sure to display the Orange flag in the holder on the telephone pole when shooting on the Trap range at all times, there is a third flag in the clubhouse as well as a flag stored in the trap building.

Outdoor shooting ranges – The outdoor ranges will be open for the year as soon as the berms Thaw, notice will be posted in the clubhouse and the flags will be located in the clubhouse next to the bulletin board.

Please observe the range rules and pick up after shooting, there is no shooting allowed from in front of the shooting stations other than a scheduled police training session.

Anyone caught violating the range rules will be brought before the E-board for a discipline hearing and punishment up to and including removal from the club roster.

Indoor Pistol Range – The indoor pistol range is closed until further notice due to mechanical issues that are being addressed by the E-board and Pistol Team. A notice will be posted on the bulletin board located inside the clubhouse next to the bar and will be addressed in upcoming newsletters and during club meetings.

PRECISION PISTOL PROGRAM

The Tyngsboro Sportsmen’s Club Pistol Team is a member of the Nashoba Valley Pistol League and competes in the N.R.A. Precision Pistol Gallery Course of Fire using pistols chambered in .22 caliber rim-fire; barrel length not more than 10 inches. Trigger pull not less than 2 pounds. Any sights, including telescopic, are permitted with the exception of those sights that project an image on the target. Open sights may be adjustable but not over 10 inches apart measured from the apex of the rear sight to the apex of the front sight. Any sighting device programmed to activate the firing mechanism is prohibited. All standard safety features of the gun must operate properly.

The NRA Gallery Course of Fire is shot standing, gun held in one hand only, the other hand being in no way being able to support the gun. All portions of the shooter's clothing, body and gun clear of artificial support. No portion of the shooter's body shall rest upon or touch the ground in advance of the firing line. The Precision Pistol shooter shoots single-handed at a distance of 50 ft. with 3 stages of fire: Slow, Timed and Rapid at 2 types of targets B-2 (7,8,9,10 rings black-bullseye 7.74 in) and B-3 (9and 10 ring black-bullseye 5.76 in).
